What's Happening

The City of Omaha and Omaha-Council Bluffs Metropolitan Area Planning Agency (MAPA) are coordinating with community members to develop the **Forever North** Strategy. The effort will:

- Build from previous plans and studies, such as the **North Omaha Village Revitalization Plan** and the **Village Square Development Plan**.
- Craft strategies for development and accommodating multiple modes of transportation.
- Thoughtfully consider corridor history and culture.
- Help increase the corridor's quality of life and competitive advantage within Omaha.
- Identify Early Action Projects.

The planning process began spring 2019 and will continue through fall 2019.
