

# 72nd & Ames Transit Access & Pedestrian Amenities

Metro and the City of Omaha are combining to improve pedestrian safety in the area of North 72nd St and Ames Ave. Metro Currently has stops which do not have amenities. There are no shelters, pads or paved surfaces from stops to the bus way, making it difficult to board and alight passengers. This project will enhance the passenger experience by constructing concrete bus pads and adding new shelters. Along with enhanced shelters, the existing sidewalks on the east of 72nd Street will be newly constructed to fix failing concrete and to meet City of Omaha standards for sidewalks. New ADA ramps will be constructed at the intersection of 72nd and Ames. These improvements will provide safe access to bus stops and adjacent properties.
