

# Cornhusker Road – 36th Street to Fort Crook Road Corridor Study

This project is a feasibility study evaluating Cornhusker Road from 36th Street to Fort Crook Road in Bellevue, Nebraska for future project programming, design, and construction. The project will involve a traffic study to determine traffic operations and deficiencies, roadway network and traffic control improvements, and pedestrian facility connectivity. The project will also involve a desktop environmental review, identifying right-of-way (ROW) impacts, and developing preliminary cost estimates.
