

Levi Carter Park Trail

A multi-use pedestrian and bicycle trail will be built along the north and west sides of Carter Lake in Levi Carter Park in order to improve safety of people walking and bicycling within the park and to better connect the park with the existing regional trail system.

Anticipated construction activity includes: grading; installation of culverts to manage stormwater runoff; construction of retaining walls in areas with cross-slopes; construction of a 10 ft wide, 6-inch thick, concrete trail; and fence installation in areas with retaining walls.
