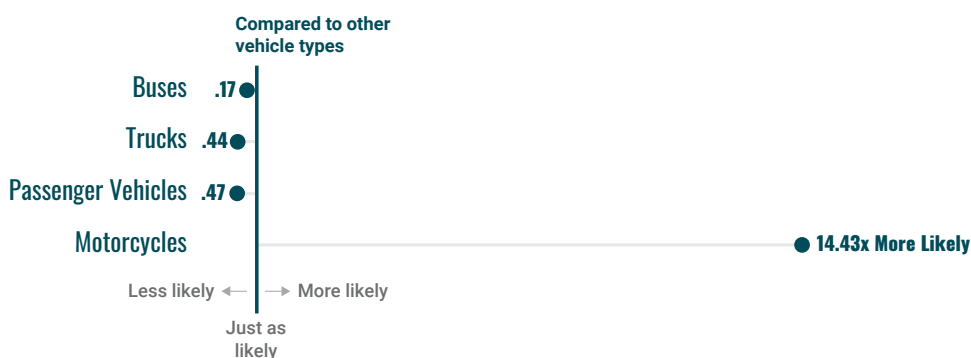

# Motorcycles

In the MAPA region, there have been 342 motorcycle-related fatalities and serious injuries between 2018 and 2022, accounting for nearly 15% of all fatalities and serious injuries in the region. Crashes involving motorcycles\* are 14x more likely to be fatally or seriously injured than other vehicle sizes.

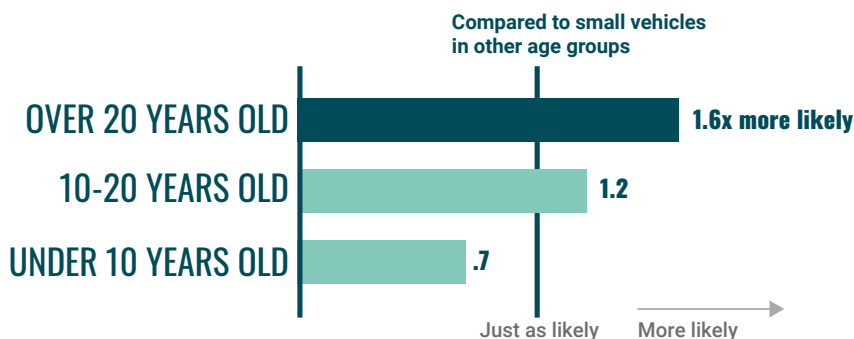

As vehicle age increases, the likelihood of being involved in a fatal or serious injury crash increases.

Nearly half (47%) of motorcycles involved in crashes are over 10 years old.
