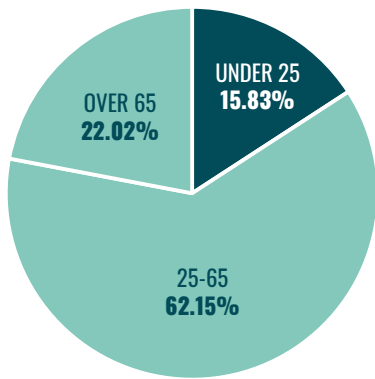

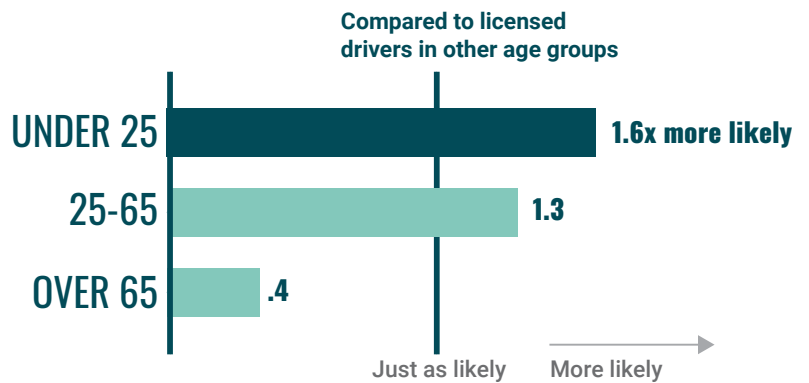
Younger Drivers

In the MAPA region, roughly 16% of all drivers are younger than 25 years old. Despite this, those under the age of 25 are 1.6 times more likely to be involved in a fatal or serious injury crash than other drivers.

Risk Ratio of Drivers Involved in Fatal and Serious Injury Crashes by Age Group



From 2018-2022, every 1 in 693 drivers under 25 years old was involved in a fatal or serious injury crash.

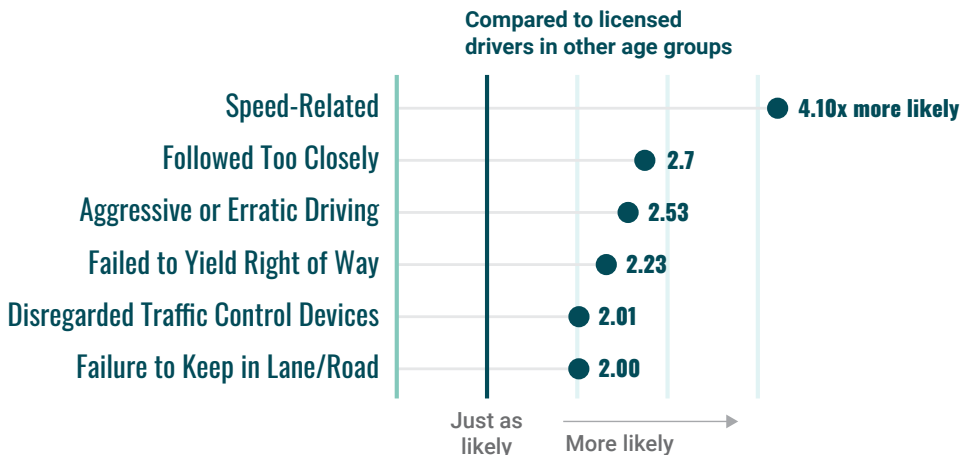

Risk Ratio of Young Driver Contributing Factors at Time of Crash (All Crashes)



Younger drivers involved in crashes are more likely to have one or more of the contributing factors shown on the left, especially those related to speed, such as driving too fast for conditions or exceeding the speed limit.
