- Environmental Site Assessments
- Clean-up
  - Site clean-up grants
  - Revolving Loan Fund
- Area Wide Planning
- Environmental Workforce Development and Job Training

# **NE Dept of Environmental Quality**

- Assessments (Section 128 (a)) Program
  - Government and non-profit applicants (sites can be privately owned)
- Asbestos remediation cost share
  - 50% of costs up to \$10,000
- Petroleum Release Remedial Action Reimbursement Fund (Petroleum tanks)
- Voluntary Clean-up Program
- Inventories also conducted

### Kansas State Technical Assistance to Brownfields



- <u>Free</u> assistance with brownfields redevelopment planning; environmental, economic development expertise
- Tailored to specific community needs
  - Fill service gaps
  - Coordinated through the city, tribal or non-profit brownfields project manager
- Communities accepted on a 'first come' basis
  - Depends on staff/funding availability
- No application process, just contact them




















# Why should I care?

- Potential health hazards from contamination
- Clean-up process complicates redevelopment
- Negative perception of sites prevents redevelopment



#### **Contamination Pathways**












# Brownfields as a catalyst for change



# Environmental Site Assessment: Phase I

- Non-intrusive/No Sampling
- Is there a concern?
- What and where?

# Environmental Site Assessment: Phase II

- Only as needed
- Sampling/Lab testing
- Confirms if there is a concern
- What and how much
- Risk analysis (pathways and populations)
  - Very helpful to have end use in mind

## Clean-up and Redevelopment

- Clean-up Plan
  - Engineering solution
  - Cost estimates
  - Voluntary clean-up and regulatory closure
- Layers of funding and partners are essential
