E. Funding Obligation and Project Status:

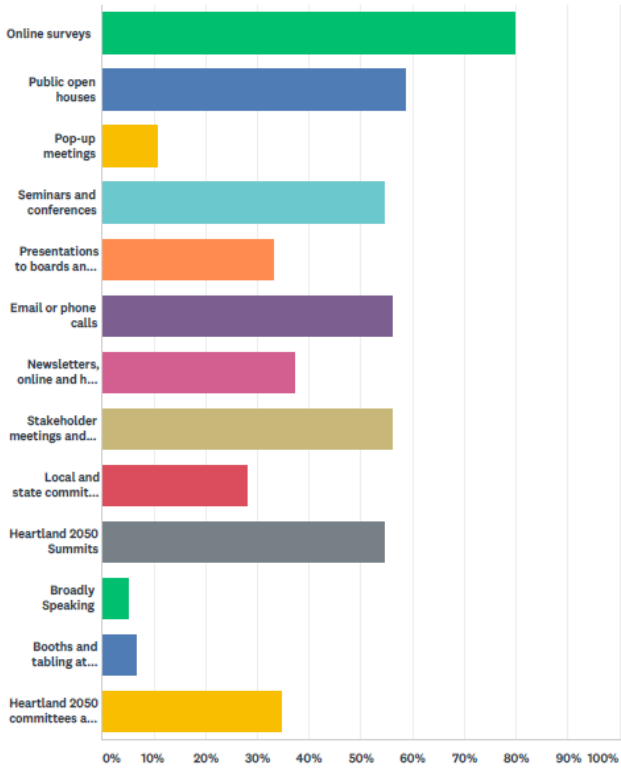
