I. Welcome / Introductions -

III. Implementation Committee Big Idea - Presented by Karna Loewenstein (Information)

Ms. Loewenstein presented to the committee. Implementation committees will bring their big ideas and recommendations to the Committee for support.

IV. Orange Splot Site Visit – Presented by Jeff Spiehs (Information)

Mr. Spiehs presented to the committee an update on the partnership between MAPA and Orange Splot for technical assistance. MAPA was awarded this technical assistance grant from AARP. Orange Splot focuses on Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU's) and missing middle housing. The site visit is expected to occur in Fall 2019 and will focus on:

- a. Code Audit for Omaha and Council Bluffs
- b. Recommendations for missing middle housing/ADU's
- c. Public Event to raise awareness of the benefits of ADU's and enhance support for City of Omaha TOD overlay on ORBT corridor
- d. Practitioner lunch for planners and developers in the region

V. Regional Efforts - Natural Resources (Information)

- a. <u>Natural Resources Inventory</u> Presented by Josh Corrigan
 Mr. Corrigan provided an update to the Committee on the Natural Resources Inventory website and answered questions.
- b. <u>Natural Resources Committee Overview</u> Presented by Patrick Leahy, Natural Resources Committee Chair Mr. Leahy provided an update to the Committee on the work of the Natural Resources Committee activities and sub-groups.
- c. Air Quality (Little Steps Big Impact) Presented by Sue Cutsforth

Ms. Cutsforth provided an update to the Committee on the 'Little Steps. Big Impact.' campaign that promotes public awareness of air quality and ozone action days. This program also conducts a school monitoring program and allows students to interact with the ozone monitors to learn more about air quality.

d. <u>Solid Waste Management</u> – Presented by Patrick Leahy

Mr. Leahy updated the committee on the Solid Waste Management sub-group activities. Currently this group is closely watching LB 580, which would increase landfill fees. These funds would then be used for education and prevention.

e. Local Foods Systems – Presented by Jeff Spiehs

Mr. Spiehs provided an update on the Local Foods Systems and "Share our Table" food plan. The plan focus areas are equitable access to nutritious food; food produced as a sustainable system; increase education on food preparation; and the root cause of hunger.

f. <u>Disaster Recovery</u> – Presented by Don Gross

Mr. Gross presented an update to the Committee on disaster recovery. MAPA's involvement will include FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) property acquisition/buyouts; housing rehabilitation; housing replacement; and public facilities.
