 - Heather E. (Civic Nebraska) Partnering with food banks and OPS food banks to spread awareness.
 - Heather B. (Census Bureau) Sent out flyers for Millard Public schools, saw a 3% increase. The Union for Contemporary Art gave a live stream and the CB helped as well as Johnny Rodgers for outreach.
 - Operational Adjustments Due to COVID-19: new schedule March 12th Oct 31st for self response, how social distancing is effecting offices and their openings for enumeration.

Framing Census Efforts

- Framing the importance of participating in the 2020 Census during the coronavirus pandemic.
 - Most self-response has been online and is exceeding expectations.

 Lack of phone response due to wait time, convenience, language issues, lack of trust over phone.

 - Helpful materials that we have been sending out via MAPA, Census Bureau and other census partners.
 - Using target audiences and community profiles to target outreach & materials to inform them of census materials.
 - Civic Nebraska is working on their media timeline with their budget to see what their options are. No specific ads for targeted groups at this time, but can be planned.
 - Congressman Bacon has done a <u>Census 2020 PSA</u> focusing on diversity and the importance of participating in the 2020 Census.
