A. Approval of the Minutes from the May 16, 2025 and June 20, 2025 Meetings

C. Amendment 8 to the FY2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Court Barber presented the amendment, which included changes to MAPA's planning projects. Pfitzer asked to clarify that this amendment is not adding any funding or projects, Barber confirmed this is correct. Kleffner moved to recommend approval of amendment 8, seconded by Hinchey. Motion carried.

E. Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update

Court Barber presented on the current status of the MTP (formerly LRTP). No member discussion.

F. USDOT SAFE ROADS Tracking

Carlos Morales provided details on Safe Arterials for Everyone through Reliable Operations and Distraction-Reducing Strategies (SAFE ROADS), a USDOT initiative to track and report progress on safety initiatives which address fatal and serious injuries on non-freeway arterial roads.

Morales requested input from the committee by Friday August 8th to submit non-HSIP funded projects planned for construction / implementation by FY2026.

McLaughlin requested that a link be distributed for pork=ject submission

Austin asked - is there funding coming out of this? Morales - we don't know. Right now they're only looking for projects that are getting completed in FY26. It seems that there may be no additional funding for this right now. Todd - projects that are getting completed in 26 - those are in year 1 of CIPs etc. MAPA is just requesting information on what they're doing. Do you want us to look at the safe streets plan and submit other projects / wishlist? Morales - right now we're just trying to meet that 60 days.

Includes maintenance work as well - painting crosswalks, replacing signage, cutting back trees etc. Includes both maintenance and construction projects

There was discussion about the content of the request and what types of projects they should submit. This is to include both maintenance and construction projects that are set to be implemented by the end of FY26. There was also discussion about future safety funding. There is no guarantee of future safety funding at this time, and this request is more to look to get a general sense of safety efforts taking place throughout the region. MAPA will send out a link to the submission tool along with additional information to clarify the request.

G. Call for Traffic Count Data for Reporting and Information on Requesting Planning Data Through MAPA

Carlos Morales provided an update on the 2024 Regional Traffic Patterns Report timeline and the process for requesting Streetlight and INRIX speed data analysis to support transportation studies or engineering design. Morales requested that jurisdictions submit any traffic count data to Jim for inclusion. Reissleman noted that the consulting firms may have count data that the city doesn't have and a request to consulting firms may be beneficial. MAPA requests all count data be submitted by Friday July 25th.
