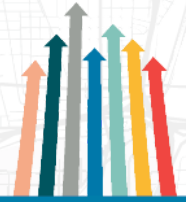

4. Nebraska Legislative Resolution 251

Melanie Davis provided an update on LR251. The resolution is expiring, but Melanie is re-drafting it and putting it forward for consideration in the new legislative term.

5. Additional Business & Public Comment

No additional business or public comments were made at this time.

6. Member Agency Updates (time permitting)

Johnson reported on Metro Transit's paratransit ridership in 2025: 790 applications, 98,070 passengers, 92,008 trips, about 400 trips per weekday. Metro will be holding public meetings in February regarding service changes.

McFall shared stats from Nebraska VR: some 3,000 clients, some 1,000+ students. McFall plans to share an updated report when it comes out.

McFall asked for members to think about their networks and consider potential committee members. Davis added that users of services other than Moby would be very helpful.

McFall adjourned the meeting at 11:23a.
